Child Protection is the term we use when a child is in danger, or at risk of suffering harm, and needs immediate support.

Safeguarding is the term we use to describe all measures that keep children safe, for example:

- First aid
- Health and Safety
- Attendance
- Staff ratios
- Rules and routines
- Implementation of policies
- Liaising with external professionals

Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is everyone's responsibility.

CiN: Child in Need **CEOP:** Child Exploitation and Online Protection Centre **KCSIE:** Keeping Children Safe in Education **Prevent:** Part of the government's central strategy to stop people being drawn into extremism
CAMHS: Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service **SEND:** Special Educational Needs & Disabilities
