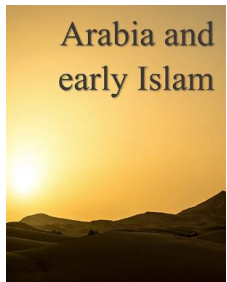


In English, our whole class text will be 'Treasure Island' by Robert Louis Stevenson, an adventure novel.

In Maths we will continue our work on statistics, then look at shape and position and direction. Times tables will be an essential part of our lessons.

In Religious Education we will learn about Pentecost and Reconciliation.

Science: Earth and Space. We learn all about the Sun, Moon and Earth and their relation to each other and the world.



Our studies in History will learn about Arabia and early Islam, learning all about the desert world before Mohammed.

In Geography, we will learn about earthquakes, why they happen, the damage they can cause and how we can predict them.

Our regular readers will read at least three times weekly. Our new reading records show our expectations at home and the children need reading records in school every day. They will also be used to communicate homework tasks. Children will read in a variety of different ways in the classroom every week.

In computing, we will In this unit, learners start to create vector drawings. They learn how to use different drawing tools to help them create images. Learners recognise that images in vector drawings are created using shapes and lines, and each individual element in the drawing is called an object. Learners layer their objects and begin grouping and duplicating them to support the creation of more complex pieces of work.



Our P.E. topic is Fitness . P.E. days are Monday and Friday. Please make sure your child comes dressed in school P.E. kit.

In Spanish we will be learning how discuss what activities we have taken part in, at home and school. We will also learn how to say how many things we have.
