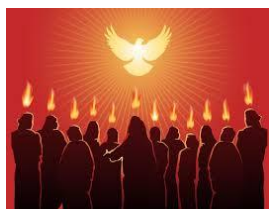




Y2 Summer Term Newsletter



Religious Education

Rules

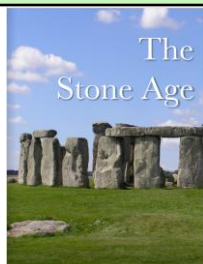
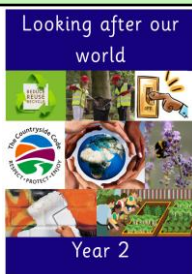
Maths

Time and statistics.

In time, we will learn to tell the time to 5 minute intervals on an analogue clock. We will also explore measuring time. In statistics, we will create pictograms and block graphs. We will learn to interpret these graphs too.

Reading and Phonics-

Phonics is taught daily using Sounds-Write to improve segmenting, blending, fluency and spelling. Sounds: r, t, z, eer



Geography

We will explore ideas that are important to our school community and then create our own project that will help us improve our school. We will carry out research and collect data from questionnaires.

History

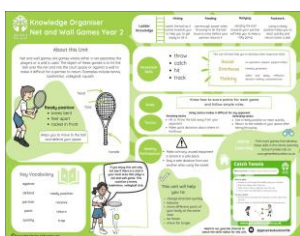
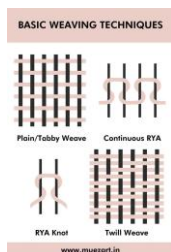
In History, we will be continuing from the Stone Age to learn about the Bronze Age and Iron Age. We learn how the technology changed with the discovery of using metals. We will also explore how life changed through these times.

Computing

This half term we will begin to programme. We will use Scratch Jr. To give instructions and create our own animations.

Science

We will be exploring where our food comes from and where different animals and plants sit in a food chain.

We will be learning about weaving and exploring how materials can be joined together to create different patterns and textures. The children will practise simple weaving techniques using a range of materials and will design and make their own woven pieces..
